Day of Prayer

We had our ministry-wide semi-annual Day of Prayer last week. One point that was shared that struck some of us was how we seem to only go to prayer for the "big" stuff. Why is that? If God can be an answer for the big things, why don't we trust him with the small stuff? While that may not mean stopping to pray about every decision, it does prompt me to re-examine our lives to see if I'm living with an open heart to the leading of God every moment of the day.

We also heard from some of our international staff in Guatemala, where one small village church has grown to almost 40 people over five months. Over 5,000 churches have been planted in that country, with over 250,000 people in those churches! We were encouraged to hear how some public schools have used the JESUS film and Proclaimers (playback devices that play audio files of Scriptures). One school principal shared how the school has changed--they used to have problems with gangs, graffiti and broken windows. Now, that school is clean, with no broken windows or graffiti. It's encouraging to hear how a public school was transformed through the exposure to Jesus that was allowed to happen there!
